Student Clinical Rotation MUW

General Principles (1)

- Medical University of Warsaw offers to foreign students clinical rotations held either in Summer period or during the academic year.
- The duration is adjusted to the student's need (preferably up to 3 months)
- The student is supervised by the English speaking tutors (if necessary)
- The quality of the rotation is assured by the regulation published in the Course Catalogue



Student Clinical Rotation MUW

General Principles (2)



- The clinical rotations are mainly supported by the schemes of widely recognized exchange programmes like Erasmus, CEEPUS, IFMSA, EMSA actions etc.
- MUW accepts also freemover mobilities.



Clinical Rotations

Quality of the rotation is assured by the regulation published in the Course Catalogue (1)

- ✓ The head of the ward or an appointed assistant is responsible for providing a detailed program of the training and scheduled duties as well as supervision of students' clinical performance.
- ✓ Students carry out the work which is that of a regular physician and are supervised by a physician in charge.



Clinical Rotations

Quality of the rotation is assured by the regulation published in the Course Catalogue (2)

- ✓ The student accompany the doctor on duty while he/she performs all the necessary clinical activities and procedures
- ✓ The goal of the clinical instruction is to make a practical use of the knowledge acquired in the course of the study e.g., bacteriology, pathomorphology, pathophysiology, pharmacology, and particularly of the clinical subjects i.e. internal medicine, pediatrics, surgery, emergency medicine.





Student Clinical Rotation- Formal Issues

- The applicant is asked to prepare in advance a kind of training/clinical rotation agreement
- Throughout the course of the training students are expected to make records of their activities and procedures performed.
- They are also assessed by the instructor in charge and are finally granted their passing mark by the head of the department.
- The student is awarded a Training Confirmation upon completion of the rotation
