Grenoble



With its 350,000 habitants, nestled in the heart of the Alps, the city enjoys panoramic views of the surrounding Belledonne, Chartreuse and Vercors mountain chains, with great opportunities for sports and nature enthusiasts.

It has a central Campus with more than 200 students associations and major campus events.

UGA: a new university



Since January 1st, 2016, the Grenoble's three universities have merged to become the new *Université Grenoble Alpes*, a world-class education in all disciplines:

- 24 academic departments (faculties or institutes)
- 14 doctoral schools

The UGA maintains partnerships with institutions from all over the world, cooperative activities, interdisciplinary research, and fosters academic, social, and cultural exchanges.

After a call for projects, in January 2016 UGA received from the French Government an amount of 13 million euros to support excellence and innovation proposals (IDEX: Prospective investments).

The Faculty of Medicine



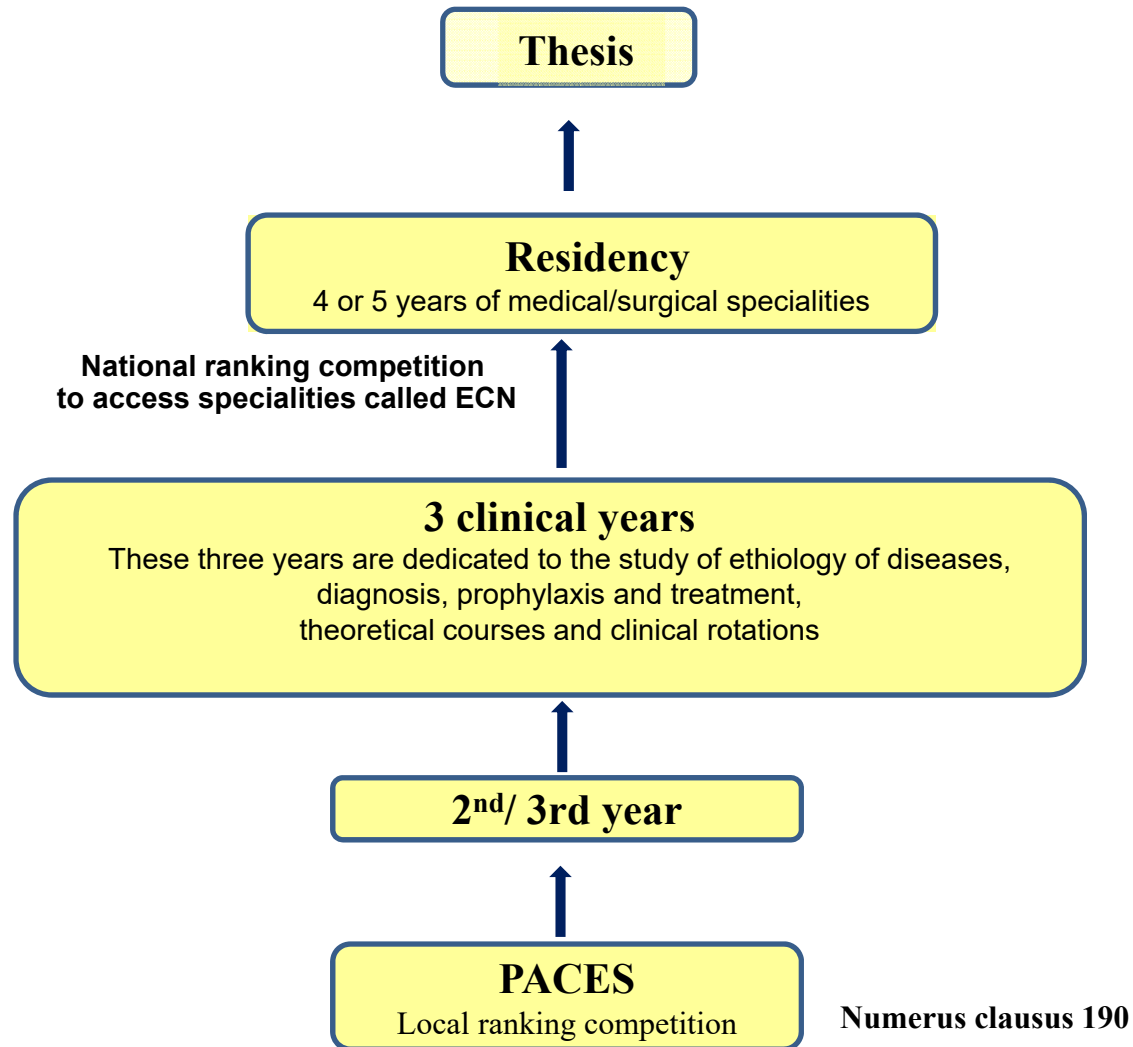
One of the oldest medical faculty of France

- **1339: Creation of « Studium de médecine de l'université du Dauphiné »**
- **1962: Faculty of medicine and pharmaceutical sciences were merged**
- **1967: Current localisation next to the university hospital (called CHU)**



- **1,800 students registered in first year (PACES):10% selected for the second year**
- **2nd cycle : 760 students**
- **3rd cycle : 350 students in general medicine + 504 in medical and surgery specialities**
- **160 Lecturers and Professors**

Curricula medical training in France



Peculiarities in Grenoble:

- Half teaching in French and in English

- Three clinical years for local students

1 module = 6 months (2 clinical rotations of 3 months each to be chosen according to a local ranking)

Missions of the IRO



- **To welcome students, residents, staff (teachers and administration)**
- **To close collaborate with hospital to identify international visitors and better organise reception of foreign medical professionals**
- **To develop partnerships**

IRO TEAM



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Outgoing students



- **4th year students**
- **Mobility: 6 months maximum**
- **Selected 1 year before mobility to validate one of the 5 modules**
- **During the period abroad: Teaching courses/ clinical rotations/ local exams**

Incoming students clinical rotations

Erasmus+/ Erasmus like (out of EU)

Length of stay : 3/6/9/12 months

Clinical rotations

Exchange students spend most of the training with rotations in different clinics. They are integrated in our clinical years according to the curriculum chosen before arrival (signed LA)

Duration= 4 weeks or 8 weeks*

Optional Teaching courses

Written exams are available upon request.

ECTS

Already existing for local students within the context of integrated training (compulsory teaching courses+ clinical rotations).

Implementation since January 2016 for Incoming students

6 ECTS = 4 weeks placement

12 ECTS = 8 weeks placement

Mobility programs

- **Erasmus+ for students : SMS et SMT**
- **Erasmus + staff mobility (3 in 2015)**
- **SCOPE organised via IFMSA**
- **Specific national facilities for residents (3rd cycle)+ bilateral agreements**
- **International credit mobility with LSU, USA 2015/2017**
