The Denmark is a modern welfare state with a population of 5.6 million of which 1.2 million live in the capital of Copenhagen. Being a knowledge based society, Denmark is dependent on a high level of education. Inaugurated in 1479, The University of Copenhagen (UCPH) is the oldest university in Denmark and highly ranked in both Europe and the world. With over 40,000 students and more than 9,000 employees, the UCPH is one of the largest institutions of research and education in the Nordic countries. The Faculty of Health and Medical Sciences is one of six faculties at UCPH. The Faculty conducts research and teaching in a wide range of disciplines within the fields of human health and medical sciences, oral health sciences, pharmaceutical sciences and veterinary medicine and animal science. With a total student body of 8,000 students, approximately 3,900 students are enrolled in the Bachelor's and Master's programme in Medicine, and 550 new medical students are admitted each year. The Faculty has partnerships and exchange agreements around the world. In total, approximately 850 international students participate in exchange and full-degree studies. The Faculty welcomes exchange students within all areas of study. Depending on the area of study, exchange students can participate in courses taught in English and/or clinical practice.

The UCPH consists of 4 campus areas. The Faculty of Health and Medical Sciences is situated in the North Campus close to the centre of Copenhagen – an international metropole with a vibrant cultural scene, historic buildings and museums, green areas and an inspiring international atmosphere.
